



## PATIENT GROUP

People with bowel cancer that has spread to other parts of the body, but who have not been given any anti-cancer treatment since the disease has spread.



## RANDOMISATION

Patients are allocated to a treatment at random.



## GROUP A: CHEMOTHERAPY TREATMENT

Capecitabine tablets twice a day for the first 14 of every 21 days. This is repeated every 21 days.



## GROUP B: CHEMOTHERAPY TREATMENT

Capecitabine tablets twice a day for the first 14 of every 21 days, plus Bevacizumab on day 1. This is repeated every 21 days.



## GROUP C: CHEMOTHERAPY TREATMENT

Capecitabine tablets twice a day for the first 14 of every 21 days, plus Bevacizumab on day 1 of every cycle, and Mitomycin C on day 1 of every second cycle for a maximum of four cycles. This is repeated every 21 days.



## FOLLOW-UP

Regular patient check-up with doctor.
