Working Group Updates

During the inaugural CommNETS meeting in 2015, a Delphi process identified both Functional Imaging (FI) and Peptide Receptor Radionuclide Therapy (PRRT) as research priorities. Although FI and PRRT are increasingly being used for the investigation and management of NET patients, considerable global variation exists in access to and use of these modalities. The working group decided to survey its existing PRRT centres with the aims of identifying and comparing the availability of different FI modalities and PRRT within CommNETs, and assessing current practices and preferences. We found considerable access disparities (particularly to Gallium-68 DOTATATE scans) and variation in practice patterns, highlighting the need for further research and a standardised approach.
