This two day intensive learning course is based on complete review of literature to understand evolution of treatment for Upper GI Cancer in the context of current treatment paradigms.

Learning is in small group interactive sessions along the Harvard short course model. Aimed at advanced trainees/ junior consultants in Medical, Radiation and Surgical Oncology, the format will be that of a short course (retreat) with learning in small groups, active participation from attendees with regard to reviewing papers, presenting cases etc.

**Topics to be covered:**

- 1. Basic biology and translational science of Upper GI Cancer and current therapies**
- 2. Seminal papers in adjuvant therapy of Upper GI Cancer**
- 3. Seminal papers in therapy of metastatic Upper GI Cancer**
- 4. Treatment paradigms for metastatic Upper GI Cancer**
- 5. Treatment pathways to achieve cure**

- Participants need to apply on-line stating why they would like to do the course and nominate papers they would like to present, and also have a case ready to present.
- Applicants will need to demonstrate understanding that this is an active learning program with pre-reading and active presentations and participation.
- Applicants will need to outline three key learning objectives you would like to achieve.
- Applicants who are not AGITG members need to submit an application for membership with their Preceptorship application.
- There will be a \$100 registration fee but all other expenses are covered.
- Attendees will be eligible for greatly reduced registration fees for the AGITG 19th Annual Scientific Meeting in Cairns on 4-6 October 2017.
